Resolution No. 2017-09

A RESOLUTION DESIGNATING CERTAIN ROADS IN PARK COUNTY AS A SECTION OF A PIONEER TRAIL.

WHEREAS, Section 30-11-27 of the Colorado Revised Statutes authorizes the Board of County Commissioners of Park County to designate, by resolution, public roads within the County as a section of a pioneer trail. A pioneer trail consist of public roads that follow as closely as possible the original trails or routes of travel of national historical significance; and

WHEREAS, in 1806 President Thomas Jefferson appointed Lieutenant Zebulon Pike as the leader of an expedition to explore territory recently acquired by the Government of the United States through the Louisiana Purchase; and

WHEREAS, in December of 1806 the Pike Expedition, during the course of its epic journey, traversed land that is now part of Park County; and

WHEREAS, portions of County Road 102, thirty-nine Mile Road/County Road 59, County Road 15, Colorado Highway 9, U.S. Highway 24, U.S. Highway 285, and County Road 439 are public roads in Park County that closely follow the route taken by the Pike Expedition; and

WHEREAS, roadside signs already exist on said County roads commemorating the national historical significance of the Pike Expedition in Park County; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the authority of the above cited statutory provision, the Board of County Commissioners desires to officially designate certain portions of said public roads as a section of a pioneer trail in Park County;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

Park County Road 102 west from Teller County Road 112 and the Park/Teller county line to Thirty-nine Mile Road/Park County Road 59; Thirty-nine Mile Road/Park County Road 50 north (from its junction with County Road 102) to County Road 15 and continuing west to the intersection of Colorado Highway 9/U.S. Highway 24, Hartsel; U.S. Highway 24 west (from its junction with County Road 15) to Trout Creek Pass and the Park/Chaffee County line (including its contiguousness with U.S. Highway 285); County Road 439 north (from its junction with U.S. Highway 24) in Hartsel to the Santa Maria Ranch gate, are hereby designated as sections of a pioneer trail to honor the achievement of the Pike Expedition as set forth above.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT:

This designation of this pioneer trail be known as the Pike Trail in Colorado.


