**A RESOLUTION MAKING FINDINGS OF FACT, CONCLUSIONS AND ENTERING AN ORDER CONDITIONALLY APPROVING THE APPLICATION OF SUNRISE SOLUTIONS FOR A PARK COUNTY MEDICAL MARIJUANA CENTER LICENSE AND AN OPTIONAL PREMISES MARIJUANA CULTIVATION LICENSE.**

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF PARK THAT the following findings of fact, conclusions and order are hereby adopted.

**FINDINGS OF FACT, CONCLUSIONS AND ORDER**

FINDINGS

1. This matter comes on for hearing upon the application of Sunrise Solutions ("Applicant" or "Licensee") for a Park County Medical Marijuana Center license and an Optional Premises Marijuana Cultivation license, to be conducted as a dual operation with the retail marijuana establishment already located at the subject site.
2. The application is complete and contains all the information required by Park County Ordinance No. 2016-3. The Board further finds that the Applicant, its officers and shareholders are of good moral character.
3. Notice of a public hearing on the application was given in the manner prescribed by Section 7(g) of Ordinance No. 2016-3.
4. A public hearing was held on the application on March 22, 2018, at which the Applicant and all interested parties were allowed to present testimony and evidence regarding the application and particularly the criteria for issuance of a license set forth in Ordinance No 2016-3.
5. The Applicant presented testimony regarding the reasonable requirements of the neighborhood and the desires of the adult inhabitants of the neighborhood.
6. No persons in interest appeared to testify against the application.

CONCLUSIONS

1. Based on the evidence adduced at the public hearing the Board concludes that there is sufficient evidence to allow it to conclude that the reasonable requirements of the neighborhood are not being met by existing medical marijuana establishments.

2. The Board further concludes that there was persuasive evidence that the desires of the adult inhabitants of the neighborhood do not disfavor issuance of the license and that the other requirements for the issuance Medical Marijuana Center license and a Medical Marijuana Optional Premises Cultivation license for this location have been met.

ORDER

Based on the Findings and Conclusions set forth above, the application for a Medical Marijuana Center license and an Optional Premises Marijuana Cultivation license is GRANTED subject to the following conditions:

1. The establishment shall not emit any detectable odor of marijuana beyond the lot lines.
2. All requirements of Park County Land Use regulations and pertinent State regulations shall apply.
3. Licensee shall abide by all State licensing requirements. All operations permitted under these licenses shall be conducted in strict compliance with Park County Ordinance No. 2016-3 and all applicable laws and regulations of the State of Colorado.

By accepting this license, the Licensee waives and releases the County, its officers, elected officials, employees, attorneys and agents from any liability for injuries, damages or liabilities of any kind that result from any arrest or prosecution of retail marijuana establishment owners, operators, employees, clients or customers for a violation of state or federal laws, rules or regulations.

By accepting this license, all licensees, jointly and severally if more than one (1), agree to indemnify, defend and hold harmless the County, its officers, elected officials, employees, attorneys, agents, insurers and self-insurance pool against all liability, claims and demands on account of any injury, loss or damage, including, without limitation, claims arising from bodily injury, personal injury, sickness, disease, death, property loss or damage, or any other loss of any kind whatsoever arising out of or in any manner connected with the operation of the retail marijuana establishment that is the subject of the license.

Licensee acknowledges that the activities authorized by this license are violations

of current federal law.


