Resolution No. 2019- 12

A RESOLUTION DENYING AN APPLICATION FOR AN OUTDOOR EVENT PERMIT FOR THE PROPOSED ELSEWHENCE EVENT FOR JULY 2019.

WHEREAS, the Applicant, David Wellhauser has filed an application for an outdoor event permit for a three-day camping, music and art event proposed to be held from July 18 through July 21, 2019 on a tract of land situated in Section 3, Township 8 South, Range 72 West, and addressed as 2703 County Road 68, Bailey, Colorado (the "Property"); and

WHEREAS, at a regularly scheduled meeting of the Park County Board of County Commissioners ("Board"), preceded by the required public notice, the Board of County Commissioners conducted a public hearing on the application for the outdoor event permit at which it reviewed the application and supporting documentation, the recommendations of the Planning Department and the Park County Planning Commission, and considered the testimony of the Applicant and patrons, and was presented with information justifying denial of the application, and found that said application fails to comply with Article V, Section 5-707 of the Park County Land Use Regulations; and

WHEREAS, specifically, the Board finds that the proposed July event will generate a significant amount of traffic leaving the event and spilling onto County Rd. 68 and Highway 285 on a Sunday in July when traffic volumes are already high and will create congestion that will impair traffic flow and emergency vehicles. Therefore, the Board finds the proposed access to the Property from the public rights-of-way is not sufficient to accommodate anticipated traffic and emergency vehicles and the application does not meet the Standard of Approval contained in § 5-707.G.9(a)(3); and

WHEREAS, further, the Board finds that the proposed July event will generate open flames during a time when the fire danger is higher than usual and dry conditions are especially acute and would result in disruption of existing uses in the immediate area. Therefore, the Board finds the proposed event is unduly disruptive to permitted or existing uses in the immediate area and the application does not meet the Standard of Approval contained in § 5-707.G.9(a)(6).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PARK COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS THAT:

The application for the Outdoor Event Permit for the proposed Elsewhence event to be held in July 2019 is denied.


