**A RESOLUTION REAUTHORIZING PREMIUM PAY FOR REQUIRED HOURS  
WORKED ON A COUNTY OBSERVED HOLIDAY FOR TEMPORARY PUBLIC  
HEALTH EMPLOYEES HIRED IN RESPONSE TO COVID-19.**

WHEREAS, the on-going COVID-19 pandemic requires continued, specialized response by Park County Public Health; and

WHEREAS, the Park County Public Health has been authorized to hire temporary and/or regular part-time employees including but not limited to COVID-19 contact tracers and a COVID-19 Information Specialist in response to COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, these temporary and/or part-time regular employees hired in response to COVID-19 may be required to perform their duties on designated County holidays;

WHEREAS, the current employment policy excludes temporary and part-time employees who work less than 20 hours per week for holiday premium pay; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PARK COUNTY BOARD OF  
COUNTY COMMISSIONERS THAT:**


Premium pay at one and one-half of the base hourly rate is reauthorized for temporary and part-time employees who work less than 20 hours per week hired by Park County Public Health specifically in response to COVID-19 including but not limited to contact tracers and an information specialist when such duties are required to be performed on a holiday. This authorized premium pay expires on July 31, 2022.
