Resolution No. 25 – 014**

**A RESOLUTION GOVERNING ADMINISTRATIVE APPROVAL OF CERTAIN
TYPES OF LIQUOR APPLICATIONS**

WHEREAS, pursuant to C.R.S. § 44-2-103(27), the Board of County Commissioners serves as the Park County Local Licensing Authority (“Park County Licensing Authority”); and

WHEREAS, the Licensing Authority can delegate certain powers to approve liquor license applications; and


WHEREAS, the Licensing Authority has determined that it is in the County's best interest to expedite the processing of specific liquor applications by allowing the County Clerk and Recorder to approve such applications administratively, subject to the terms outlined in this Resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Park County acting as the Park County Licensing Authority that:

1. The County Clerk and Recorder is hereby delegated with administrative authority to decide the following applications, subject to the appeal of the Park County Licensing Authority:
 - a. Renewal of an existing County license.
 - b. Change of corporate structure or trade name of an existing County license.
 - c. Modification of premises of an existing County license.
 - d. Temporary liquor permits or licenses.
2. The County Clerk and Recorder may refer any application to the Park County Licensing Authority when, in the determination of the County Clerk and Recorder, the public interest would be best served by determining the matter at a public hearing.
3. Any application denied by the County Clerk and Recorder may be appealed to the Park County Licensing Authority by filing an appeal in writing to the County Clerk and Recorder within ten (10) business days of the denial and must include a request for a hearing. Appeals to the Park County Licensing Authority will be decided *de novo*.
